Note From Registrar About Renewal Process

I am pleased to say that nearly all of our Unit Renewals have been posted and I'm presently working on member renewals that leaders assigned me to do manually from funds in custodial accounts at the office. If National keeps to their notification schedule when this new process was rolled out in August, then Adult Scouters and parents of youth members who had a 12/31/2024 registration expiry date have received their last 7 days past expiry notification to renew membership.

If you were notified by Unit leaders to process your own renewal (or in the case of a youth renewal-the parent), then you want to move on it now. I am concerned the link may not be functional the further away we get from 12/31/2024. The renewals are done from a my scouting account:

After logging in to our account, click on Menu in the upper left corner.

Select My Application.

There are 4 tabs in this section, click on the far right one-My Renewals. I have been told it is not easy to find this tab when using a mobile device.

Click on Start Renewal.

If you do not see the individual to be renewed in this tab, please reach out to me via email, Pamela.Legried@scouting.org, or call my direct line, 507-361-5341.

Key 3 Leaders: I encourage you to get in a regular schedule of logging in to your my.scouting acount>Menu>Roster to check from the expandable Members Renewal Orders at the bottom for any Submitted orders that are not finished. There is a Report section in the Roster tool and I recommend running the Members Due to Renew report at least once a month to manage members with upcoming expiration dates. You will also see from this report the email address associated with youth members. This is the email address for the parent that is getting the renewal notifications from National.

Thank you all for your patience and understanding during this new renewal process. It has been a journey but we can reach our destination with the help of each other! Wishing you a blessed and adventurous new year of Scouting!

Attention Leaders & Scouts.

A quick reminder to everyone that the Black Pug event and training software the council uses has a lot of benefits in helping with keeping track of where things are with signups, as well as a follow up to who attended the event or training, etc. If you set up an account in Black Pug you will have the added benefits of being able to see your history of who has registered & attended. Also, if a parent registers and uses the youth's correct Unit number, this information shows on the Unit account that the Cubmaster or Scoutmaster oversees for their unit, etc.

As the seasons change and new leaders come on board it is important that new leaders have access s to their Black Pug unit account. I can help you with that process and show you some pointers on how easy this application is to use.

- •Elbert K. Fretwell Outstanding Educator Award: recognizes educators who promote Scouting values in their students. The award is given to teachers, administrators, and educational support staff in public, private, religious, and charter schools.
