Hi, I'm Kelly Wilde and I am the Camp Director at Camp Decorah in Holmen, WI. and I would like to invite your Scout to be a part of our Provisional Crossover Troop. Crossover Troop is for those Scouts who can't make it to Summer Camp with their troop, or their troop is going to a camp that is a long way from home. Our 2 required leaders are trained Scoutmasters.


They'll be enrolled in our Brownsea Program for first year Scouts and then have the opportunity to take 2 more merit badges. You may even be able to earn 2 more with our afternoon Pop Up Merit Badges. You can also visit your Scout on Wednesday night and join them for dinner, which they will cook for you in their campsite. (Camp Decorah is about 77 minutes from Rochester)

And Camp Decorah is a "walking camp" meaning you can get from one end to the other in about 10 minutes. We are a Nationally Accredited SBSA Camp and were recently named Best Summer Camp in La-Crosse County. Facilities and features include a full-service dining hall, shooting ranges, swimming pool and large waterfront area including a stocked fishing pond, a four-sided climbing tower, Low COPE elements, bouldering wall, 5-mile professionally designed mountain bike trail, handicraft facilities, nature center, nature trail network, zipline and much more.

Earn Your "Trained" Strip- Attend IOLS!

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills, or IOLS, builds and expands on the concepts and themes introduced in Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training and provides Scouters with the confidence to take youth into the outdoors.

Specifically, this hands-on program gives adult leaders a practical introduction to the patrol method of a scout-led troop by teaching many of the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. In addition, the teaching methods, activities, and games model the variety of teaching used in effective and engaging Scouting programs.

Course date is May 16th &17th - This course is the final step to earn your "TRAINED LEADER" strip!

Hazardous Weather Training - Keeping Up To Date

In 2017, Hazardous Weather Training was made mandatory for all Direct Contact Leaders, however completion of this training has not been properly reflected in training reports.

All Direct Contact Leaders are required to complete Hazardous Weather Training to be considered "trained" in their position: Cubmaster, Asst. Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Asst. Scoutmaster, Den Leader, Asst. Den Leader, Crew Advisor, Associate Crew Advisor, Exploring Advisor, Associate Exploring Advisor, and Sea Scout Adult Leader.

Leaders should receive an email notification of their expiration date, from my.scouting (similar to Youth Protection emails). Leaders can also see their training status in their my. Scouting account under My Training/completions. Direct Contact Leaders must complete Hazardous Weather training every two years to retain "trained" status.

Note: Hazardous Weather Training can ONLY be completed using the on-line modules offered through my.scouting.
