Hazardous Weather Training - Keeping Up To Date

In 2017, Hazardous Weather Training was made mandatory for all Direct Contact Leaders, however completion of this training has not been properly reflected in training reports.

All Direct Contact Leaders are required to complete Hazardous Weather Training to be considered "trained" in their position: Cubmaster, Assistant Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Asst. Scoutmaster, Den Leader, Asst. Den Leader, Crew Advisor, Associate Crew Advisor, Exploring Advisor, Associate Exploring Advisor, and Sea Scout Adult Leader.

Leaders should receive an email notification of their expiration date, from <u>my.scouting</u> (similar to Youth Protection emails). Leaders can also see their training status in their my.Scouting account under My Training/completions. Direct Contact Leaders must



complete Hazardous Weather training every two years to retain "trained" status.
