Ideal Month of Scouting:

Unit Meetings: 1-3 times per month.

Each month has a theme developed by the pack committee (Cub Scouts) or the Patrol Leaders Council (Scouts BSA). The meetings should occur at a regular schedule and frequency for your families to remember (i.e. "The First and Third Mondays, etc.).

Committee Meeting: 1 per month

This is time for the unit committee to review the unit's work, progress, calendar, and other important functions in order to establish a healthy baseline. The unit leader should give a report on the youth, treasurer should give a report on finances, and advancement chair should give a report on awards earned. The Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) should be invited to committee meetings for Scouts BSA troops.

Patrol Leaders Council: 1 per month (Scouts BSA Troops)

For Scouts BSA troops, this is time for the Senior Patrol Leader, their assistants, the Patrol Leaders, and any invited troop staff to plan the next month for the troop. The meeting should be led by the Senior Patrol Leader, with minimal adult involvement.

Unit Outing: 1 per month

This is time to put the unit meetings and practices into action! Each month should involve a theme that "builds" to the unit outing, whether it is a field trip, hike, skills practice, campout, or other event. For Scouts BSA troops, the January, April, and September camporees are great unit outings to involve in the month's theme.

Patrol / Den Meetings: 1-3 times per month

Each patrol and/or den should meet outside of the unit meeting 1-3 times per month. These meetings can focus on the monthly theme, on advancement, or on other things.

Roundtable / Leader Support: Varies

Your local Scout Units may meet monthly, quarterly, or on another schedule. These are times to ask questions, learn best practices from other leaders, and get learn about district and council updates.


